Meet, talk and enjoy time with other local men, the group is interesting, informative and fun.

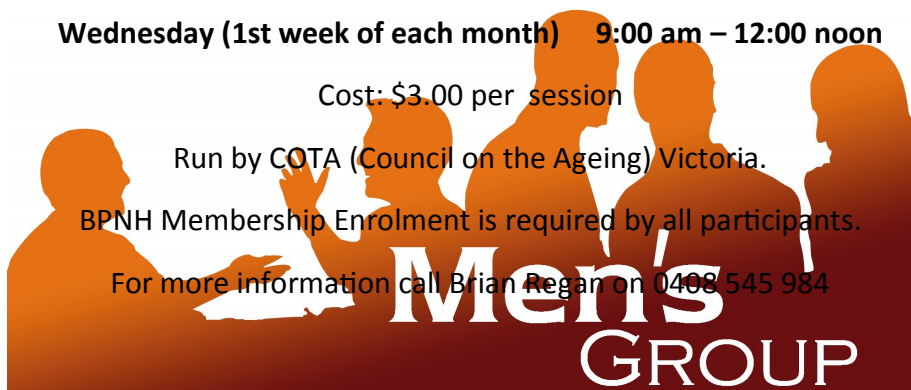
